AFFECTS	1616*601B SNOWDOGG PLOW CONTROLLERS								
INFORMATION	A change to the behavior of the SnowDogg plow controllers was made in the 2022-2023 to prevent accidental movement.  It is now necessary to pause for ~1 second between entering FLOAT mode and entering MOUNT mode. If the operator attemptes to enter MOUNT mode immediately after entering FLOAT, the controller will not allow it and the operator will need to leave FLOAT mode before trying again.  This is intended to prevent the accidental entry into MOUNT mode while operating the plow in FLOAT mode and causing unexpected behavior.								
INSTRUCTIONS	TO ENTER MOUNT MODE								
	1. PRESS DOWN FOR 1 SECOND UNTIL THE INDICATOR TURNS BLUE - THE PLOW IS IN FLOAT MODE								
	2. RELEASE THE BUTTON FOR 1 SECOND								
	3. PRESS DOWN FOR 1 SECOND UNTIL THE INDICATOR FLASHES RED - THE PLOW IS IN MOUNT MODE								
	PLEASE INCLUDE THIS INSTRUCTION WITH MOUNT TRAINING OF END USERS AND CUSTOMERS
